

Does the disabling of entities at grain  $g_j$  cause a change in report ( $R'$ )?

**NO** (assumed *not* to occur in our analysis)

**YES** (a starting assumption of our analysis)

Inductive evidence for **actualism**

Are there any causal consequences?

**YES**, and they cause a change in B (assumed *not* to occur in our analysis)

**YES**, and there are many, or they go close to B; or  $R'$  takes a long time

**YES**, but there are few, or they stay close to G; or  $R'$  happens fast

**NO** (unlikely in practice)

(A completely conventional explanation for  $R' / B^{*}$ )
